Statement from TEU and Corinthian Union on Jeld-Wen Campaign

The Timber Employees Union of Peninsula Malaysia (TEUPM) and its affiliate, the Corinthian Timber Workers Union, supports the ongoing campaign of the CFMEU members in Jeld-Wen's Australian based companies, including Corinthian, William Russell Doors and Stegbar.


We believe the ongoing actions of Jeld-Wen and its subsidiaries constitute a rejection of the requirement to bargaining in good faith with the workers and the union. By offering employees a pay-raise below the CPI rate, even after the workers previously worked with the company to ensure ongoing profits and the reduction in operation costs during the global financial crisis, Jeld-Wen is not respecting its workers.

The TEUPM and Corinthian Union supports the union's efforts and the actions being taken by the workers around Australia. It is difficult to continue fighting against a company when they are not bargaining in good-faith, when they lock workers out of their factories and when they refuse to recognise the right for workers to be represented by their trade union, but we believe you can win.

We are currently also undergoing Enterprise Bargaining Agreement negotiations with Corinthian in their Malaysia factory and feel that your efforts and campaign stands as inspiration for us as we shape our demands and unite under the union to win a fair and decent deal for all members.

Keep fighting, we stand beside you in your struggle.
